FUNDarte announces its 21st season of performing arts. This season we are pleased to announce an extensive program of live events for the whole family with various poetics and artistic disciplines.

Our 2023-24 Season features fresh offerings grouped within FUNDarte's various signature series, which have by now become popular micro-festivals that allow us to explore specific themes. Dance, music, theater for audiences of all ages, exhibitions, and educational activities will have space in this year's edition of our ZunZún Children's Fest, FL Flamencos, No Borders, Global Cuba Fest, and Out in The Tropics series.

For 21 years, FUNDarte has been nurturing South Florida audiences with a year-round diet of live arts experiences that not only reflect the origins and identities of our local communities, but also push the limits and boundaries of contemporary artistic expression, amplifying cultural understanding and literacy. FUNDarte's programs are known for blurring the definitions of artistic disciplines, expanding cultural perspectives far beyond the boundaries of commercial offerings, and celebrating innovative creation in its many diverse and quirky forms. Our goal is to present the most innovative, risky, honest, and relevant art works from around the world to audiences in Miami and the greater South Florida community.

Known for our bold approach, diverse lineup, and our penchant for presenting artists just before they explode on the global art scene, FUNDarte is proud to showcase Latinx artists, Spanish-language and bilingual theater and literary events, and works by local artists as well as artists from all over the world.



This year's season features an exciting program of live theater for children as well as adults, in addition to dance, music, and multidisciplinary performances. Our ZunZun Children's Fest provides live bilingual theater and performing arts programs for children and families, while our FL. Flamencos series explores contemporary and experimental flamenco forms and other genres from Spain and the Americas. No Borders brings international risk-taking artists, Global Cuba Fest showcases the music of the Cuban diaspora, while Out in the Tropics explores topics of interest to the LGBTQIA+ community.

Our 2023-2024 Season features artists and work from Spain, Mexico, Argentina, and artists based in the U.S. with innovative new projects in various disciplines.

FUNDarte also oversees the Miami Dade County Department of Cultural Affairs' Artist Access Grant Program, as a reflection of our commitment to fostering a robust artistic community in South Florida. The Artist Access Grant awards funds to professional artists in Miami-Dade County to help them develop their artistic careers.

ZunZún Children's Fest 2024 features three days of interactive programming for children and families, featuring a program of children's musical theater by various artists; an interactive, immersive installation; and musical programs in English and Spanish by local and visiting artists, including a Grammy Award winner.

Eroticism, sensuality, and the political subtext - hallmarks of its director, maestro Carlos Díaz - emerge in this piece in communion with Afro-Cuban folklore and the Iberian tradition seen from the other shore. *Celestina* premiered at the "Clásicos en Alcalá" Festival in Madrid, Spain, in July 2023.

In Un poyo rojo, two men play with movement, an analog radio, and tiny shorts in an empty locker room. The athletic bodies of Luciano Rosso and Alfonso Barón move fluently from wrestling to dance, acrobatics to physical comedy in an irresistible distortion of the expectations of manhood. A funny, raw, playful hour interspersed with competitiveness and camaraderie, as well as seduction and sabotage, showcases the best Argentinian contemporary dance.

SPECIAL PROJECTS:

Lukas Avendaño (Mexico) + Miami Artists.

As part of this season's international cultural partnership program, FUNDarte will produce a new contemporary dance piece with Miamibased artists in partnership with Mexican dancer, activist, and choreographer Lukas Avendaño.



Lukas Avendaño (Oaxaca, 1977) is a Mexican performance artist and anthropologist who identifies as a muxe. His work is characterized by exploring sexual, ethnic, and gender identity.

In his newest work LEMNISKATA, a choreography for 14 male dancers and one female performer, Avendaño portrays the origin of life based on female symbols from Mexican culture. With the movements of their naked bodies, the dancers visualize infinity. With an impressive stage set, sound design based on pre-Hispanic instruments, colorful humananimal masks, and live music, this new work is an experience for all the senses.

Artist Access Grant

Funded by Miami-Dade County and managed in partnership with FUNDarte, the Artist Access Grant Program is designed to assist practicing, professional artists working in any medium or discipline and residing in Miami-Dade County to pursue professional development opportunities that will advance their practice and careers in significant and measurable ways.

Eligible opportunities include professional development and skill-building opportunities that expand an artist's skill base, such as specialized classes or workshops, artist residencies, technique classes with master artists, conferences, teaching artist training, arts leadership training, and other non-credit artistic learning opportunities (in person or virtual). Applicants must demonstrate how the potential, timeliness, and impact of the opportunities will propel the artist's career to a new level. Artists can receive awards up to \$2,000.
